

## Slips, Trips, and Falls Prevention

In NCC T&D's business operations, slip, trip, and fall hazards present significant risks, especially at the project site. Proper housekeeping is essential for preventing accidents and maintaining efficient operations.

### NCC T&D Project Leaders Key Responsibilities

Project Leaders must ensure:

- Development of site-specific housekeeping plans
- Implementation of daily cleaning schedules
- Regular workplace inspections
- Proper lighting in all work areas
- Adequate drainage in wet areas
- Clear communication of safety requirements
- Enforcement of PPE standards

### Site Maintenance Requirements

Mandatory daily tasks:

- Removal of construction debris
- Clearing of walkways and access points
- Management of cable runs and cords
- Cleaning of spills immediately
- Removal of snow and ice when present
- Organization of tools and equipment
- Maintenance of proper lighting

### Worker Responsibilities

All workers must:

- Conduct pre-work area inspections
- Clean up their work areas continuously
- Report hazards immediately
- Use designated walkways only
- Wear appropriate footwear
- Maintain clear access to electrical equipment
- Practice good housekeeping habits

### Special Considerations

Additional requirements include:

- Cable management around equipment
- Clear access to emergency switches
- Proper drainage near electrical installations
- Non-slip surfaces in control rooms
- Clear evacuation routes
- Proper storage of insulating materials
- Management of oil spills from transformers

### Inspection Requirements

Daily checks for:

- Walking surface conditions
- Adequate lighting
- Proper drainage
- Clear access/egress routes
- Proper storage practices
- Cable/cord management
- Weather-related hazards

## **Prevention Strategies**

Implement:

- Non-slip walking surfaces
- Proper drainage systems
- Cable management solutions
- Adequate lighting systems
- Weather protection measures
- Clear signage
- Regular maintenance schedules

## **Emergency Response**

Ensure:

- Clear evacuation routes
- Accessible emergency equipment
- First aid stations
- Communication systems
- Response team coordination
- Incident reporting procedures
- Medical support access
